We present to you the tenth session of the summer school of architecture; the basic topic "process in architecture" is aimed at researching the process of architectural design (as a thinking process) from idea to its implementation namely the multitude of inter-processes and multi-significance of this inter-space.

The relation process-change is constantly present irrespective of our awareness of it. We build the buildings so that they shall last long! Fast changes and the spatial support are contrary with this longevity. Intensive communications at all levels of information, the nearly limited quantum of information and their accessibility increase the complexity and significance of the above mentioned relations.

Architecture is not measured only by aesthetic criteria of the beautiful and ugly in its appearance but also by the possibility of its adjustment, too.

Utilitarianism becomes necessity and the first criteria.

The town of Kriva Palanka is the location of the experiment; the program shall offer selection of challenging workshops led by mentors, lectures and other events in the monastic complex.

Candidates (students) should apply with a portfolio and statement why they want to participate at the summer school and a recommendation;

Candidates (graduated architects and urban planners, post-graduates, doctorants, assistants, lecturers, researchers) for mentors should also provide a concept of a 30 minute lecture which they are to present to the 55/2001 participants, which are to be sent to
